

Culture Moves Europe

is a mobility scheme that supports **individual mobility** and **residency projects** across the Creative Europe countries.

Call for Individual Mobility

Open to **artists and cultural professionals** (individuals or groups).

Who can apply?

Individuals aged 18 and above (no upper age limit!) residing in a Creative Europe country, regardless of their nationality.

This grant is open to architects, sound technicians, ceramists, poets, photographers, dancers, designers, curators, writers, DJs, and many more!

We welcome all levels of experience: from emerging to established.

You can apply individually or in a group project. 😊



Group projects

Group projects can include up to **5 applicants**, with one of them acting as the group leader.

All group members must:

- meet the eligibility criteria and provide the required documents.
- implement the project in the **same place**, at the **same time** and for the **same duration**.

Group members can come from **different countries** and be active in **different sectors**. It can also be their first collaboration. 😊



Creative Europe countries

All 27 countries in the European Union

+ Albania, Armenia, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Georgia, Iceland, Kosovo*, Liechtenstein, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Norway, Serbia, Tunisia, Ukraine.

Overseas Countries and Territories (OCTs) and Outermost Regions (ORs)

- Greenland (*Denmark*);
- French Guiana, French Polynesia, French Southern and Antarctic Territories, Guadeloupe, Martinique, Mayotte, New Caledonia, Reunion Island, Saint Barthelemy, Saint-Martin, St. Pierre and Miquelon, Wallis and Futuna Islands (*France*);
- Azores, Madeira (*Portugal*);

What do you need to apply?

- ✓ **One mobility project** to be carried out in another Creative Europe country, with the support of an international partner.

In the application form, you'll be asked for a short description of your project, why the mobility is important, etc.

- ✓ **One international partner** who collaborates with you during the project implementation in the destination country.

- ✓ **Supporting documents:**

- official national identification **
- proof of residence in a Creative Europe country **
- short curriculum vitae (CV) **
- artistic and creative portfolio
- letter of invitation from the international partner

Example of an individual mobility project



Stefania developed a circus performance with other international artists, in Denmark.

She travelled from Croatia to Denmark **by train**.

There, she implemented a project for **15 days**.

Objectives:

To Create + To Connect

Grant =

1.275 € (daily allowance)
+ 400 € (travel allowance)
+ 400 € (green top-up)

Total amount: 2.075 €





Example of a group project



Kyriaki, Davina, and Yoan explored the local architecture and attended workshops in Bucharest about sustainable construction and design.

They applied as a **group** to implement a project in Romania for **10 days**.

- Kyriaki took a **flight** from Cyprus.
- Davina took a flight from Poland, together with her non-professional **sign language interpreter** (no other accessibility costs).
- Yoan took a **flight** from Armenia. He is the father of a 3-year-old.

Objectives:

To Learn + To Explore

Grant:

Kyriaki: 1.250 € (no top-ups)

Davina: 2.500 € (accessibility support)

Yoan: 1.570 € (family + visa top-ups)

Total amount: 5.320€

How to apply?

Go to the [Goethe-Application Portal](#) (GAP) and:

1. Create a GAP account
2. Register as an **'Individual'** (even for group projects)
3. Select **'Culture Moves Europe'**,
then **'Call for Individual Mobility'**
4. Complete the form in English.
You can save and edit until final submission.


